



You will need 8 x Flat 8 x Bolts Washers (H1) (H2)1 x Allen Key (H3)


Loosely attach the leg frames to bench seat (P1) with 8 x bolts (H1) and 8 x flat washers (H2) using Allen key (H3).




1 x Allen Key

Note: Assemble the dining table on a soft flat surface to prevent unit from being damaged during assembly.

There are two positions available on the table top (P1) for the leg frames to be assembled. Please choose one before proceeding.

Option 1 allows you to place chairs on the sides of the table for users to have easy conversations.

Option 2 is best suited if you are having bench seats as you will be able to tuck them under the table when not in use.





Fix the legs frame (P3) to legs frame (P2). with 8 bolts (H1) & 8 flat washers (H2). Tighten the bolts using Allen key (H3).






2 Assembly Options




Option 1

Dining chairs can be pushed in under the table at both ends



Attach the leg frames to table top with 8 x bolts and 8 x flat washers. Make sure the leg frame position is 225mm from table edge. Tighten the bolts using an



Option 2

Setup for Portofino Bench seating



Step 1: Disassemble the leg frames.

Step 2:

Attach the leg frames to the table top with $8 \times \text{bolts}$ and $8 \times \text{flat}$ washers. Make sure the leg frame is flush with the table top edge. Tighten the bolts using an Allen key
