

Assembly checklist




Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information


- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.

Insert Front Legs (P3) into the corresponding holes in Seat Frame (P2). Attach using 4 x Washers (H3) and 4 x Medium Bolts (H2). Do not fully tighten bolts, leave a little loose at this stage.







Insert 1 x medium Bolt (H2) and 1x Washer (H3). Do not fully tighten bolts, leave a little loose at this stage.



Attach Seat Frame (P2) to Back Frame (P1) using 4 x Washers (H3) and 4 x Long Bolts (H1). Do not fully tighten, leave a little loose at this stage.



Apply downward pressure on the seat pad to ensure the chair is level before tightening all bolts firmly with Allen Key.


Read Instructions carefully.


Carefully identify each component, especially


Separate and identify each component from the
hardware pack and rest each one in its proper
location before fastening.

DO NOT fully tighten screws (leave slightly
loose). When the item is fully assembled
tighten the screws - but do not over tighten.



Please make sure you have all these parts before you start.

Step 1

Note: Assemble the table on a soft flat surface to prevent the table top from being damaged during assembly.




Position the legs against the table top so the bolt holes line up.

Step 2



8 x Flat
Washer
Ø23 x 2mm
(H3)



Fix the 2 x Legs (P2) to the Table Top (P1) using 4 x Bolts (H5), 8 x Flat Washers (H3) and 4 x Nuts (H4), and tighten them together by hand only.






Insert 4 x Bolts (H2), and 4 x Flat Washers (H3) in to the corner bracket and tighten lightly so 2 mm is left.




Step 4

**Note: Turn the Table upright by a team of two people.
Adjust the Table Top to level with the Legs.**


2 x Spanners




Using 2 x Spanners (H1) tighten 4 x Bolts (H5) and 4 x Nuts (H4) in the middle of the Table Top (P1) and the Leg (P2) 'tighten firmly'.

You will need:




Spanner



Then tighten 4 x Bolts (H2) in the corner bracket firmly.
