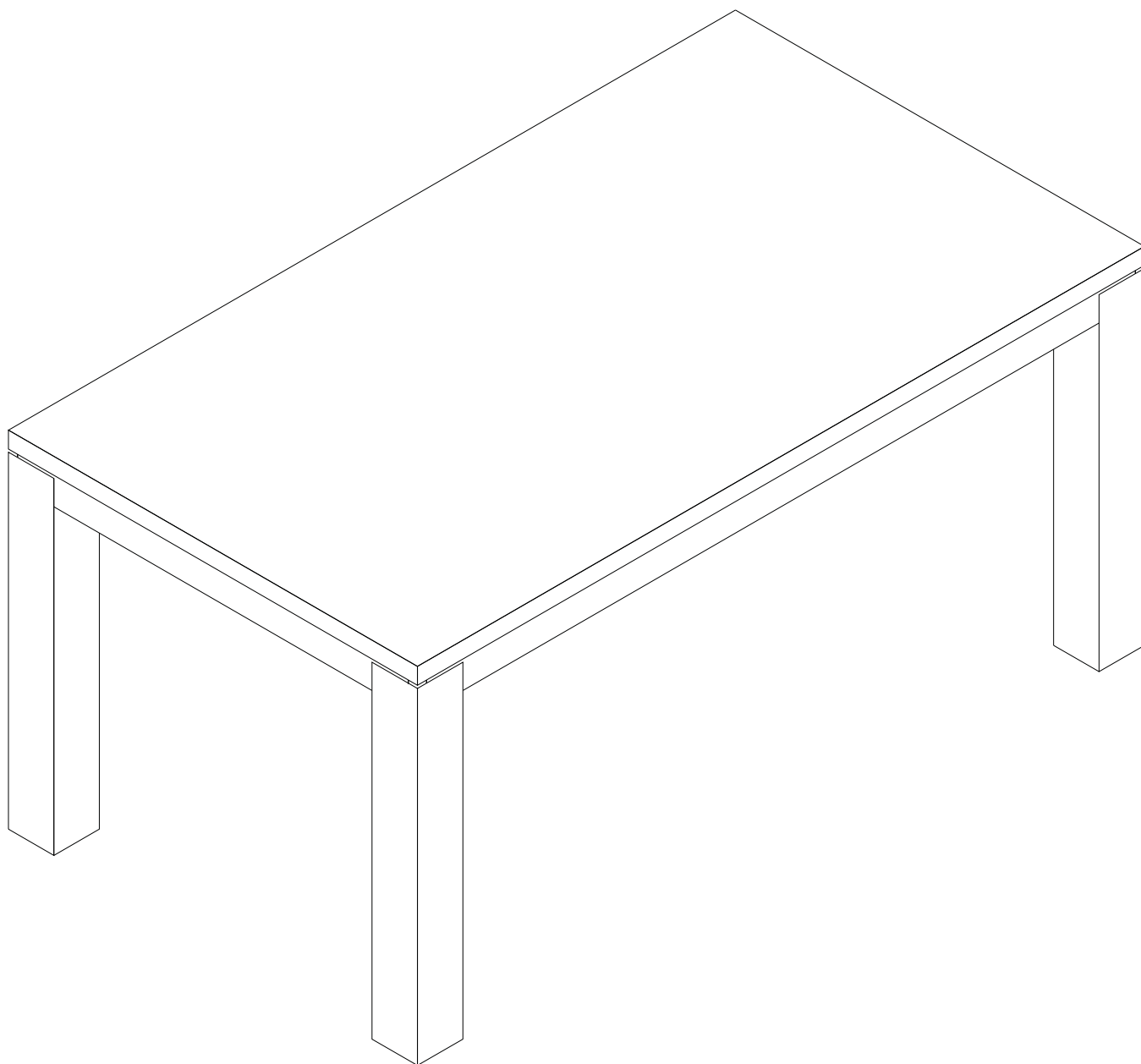

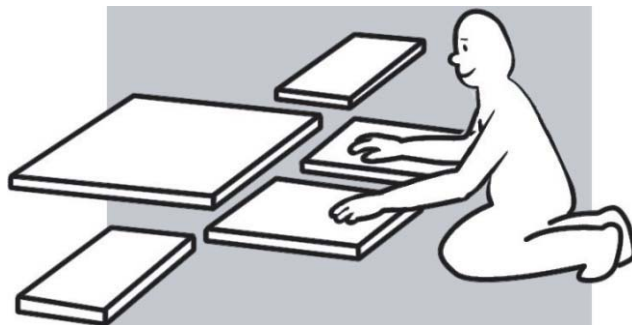

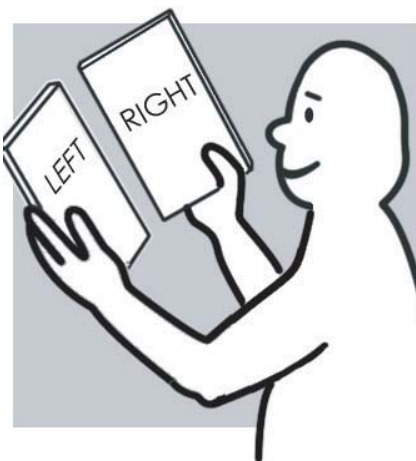
Read Instructions carefully.

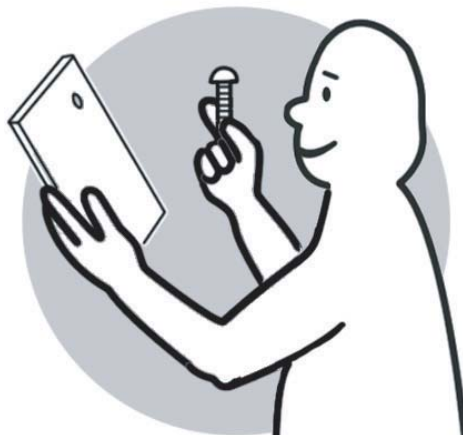
Lay out all of the components on a soft surface

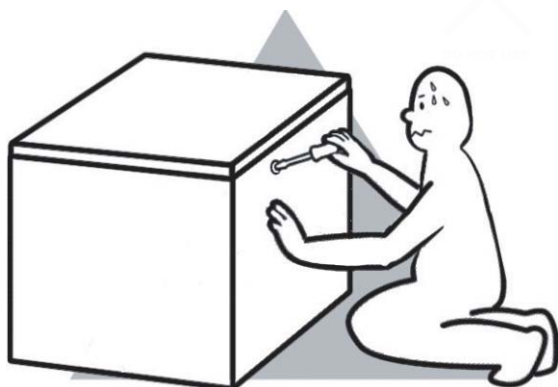
Carefully identify each component, especially  
those that are similar. The most common mistake  
is getting things back to front.

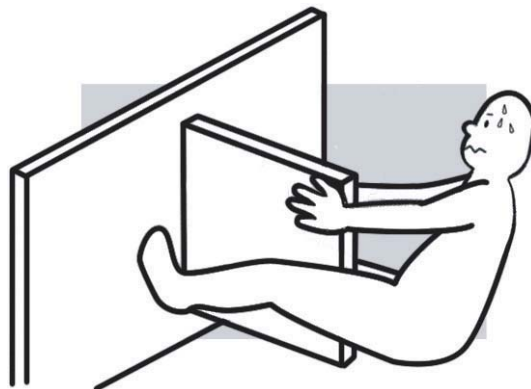
Separate and identify each component from the  
hardware pack and rest each one in its proper  
location before fastening.

**DO NOT** fully tighten screws  
(loose). When the item is fully assembled  
tighten the screws - but do not over tighten.

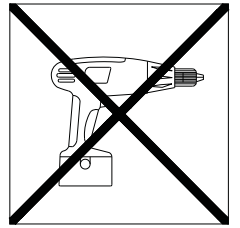

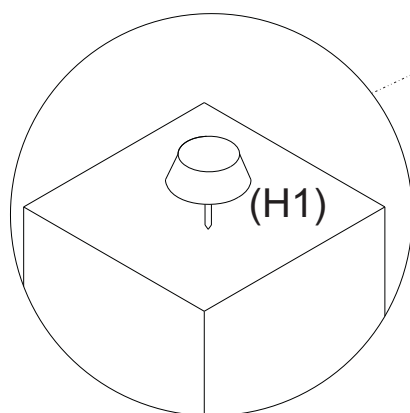
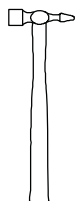
# Step 1



Turn the carton upside down (Bottom up).  
Open the carton and remove all foam.  
Remove item from carton turn over and unwrap.

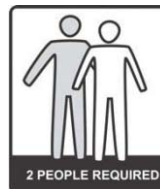





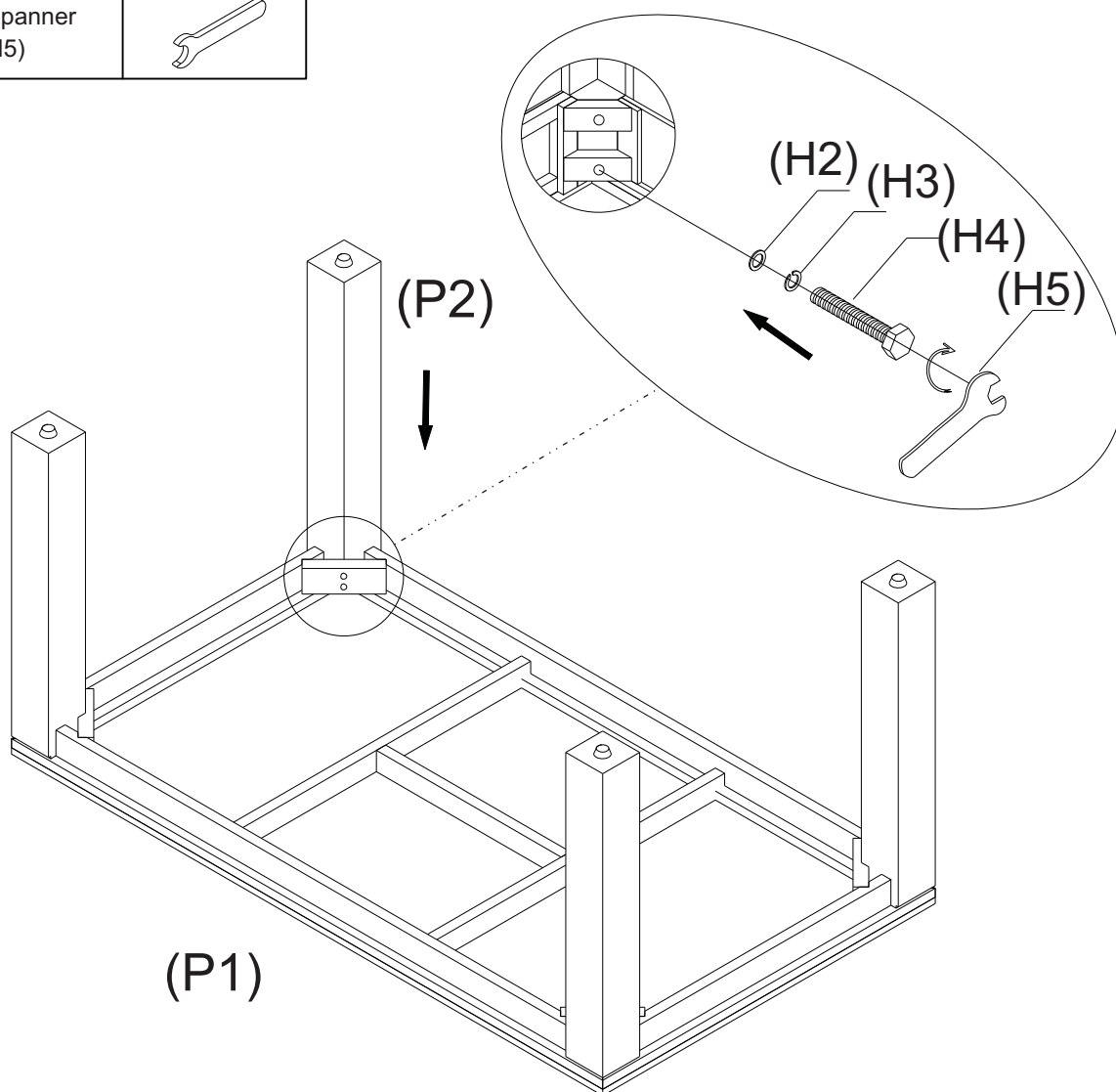
Use a hammer to nail the gliders (H1) to the legs.

# Step 3



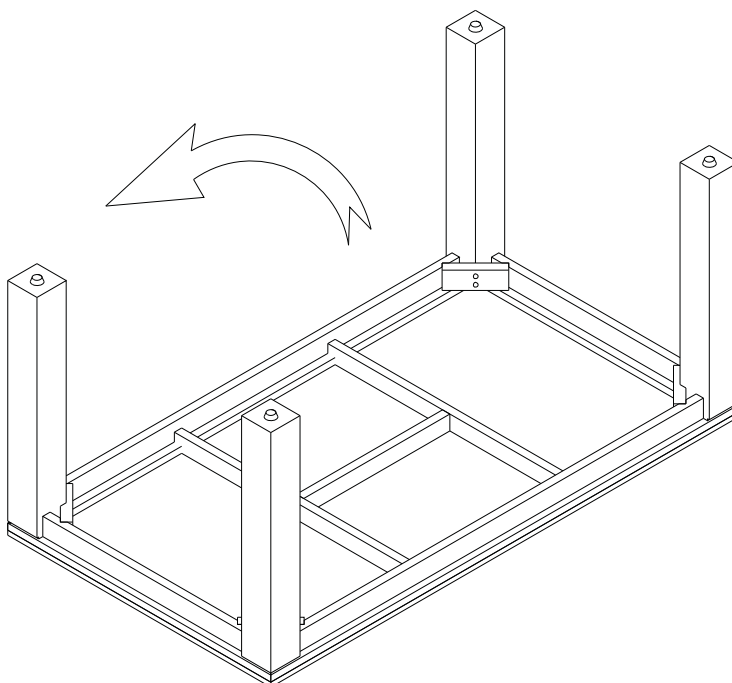
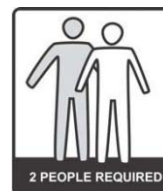

| 1 x Spanner<br>(H5)        |  |

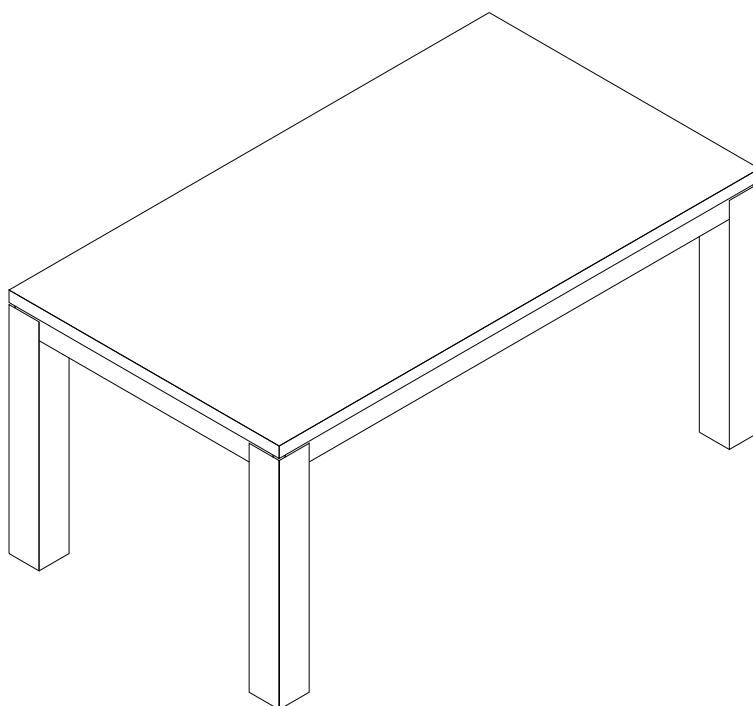


Put spring washer (H3) and then flat washer (H2) onto bolt (H4).  
Align the legs (P2) with table top (P1) and fix with bolt (H4).  
Use spanner (H5) to tighten.

## Step 4



Now turn the table over not touching the ground during the process.

# Assembly checklist



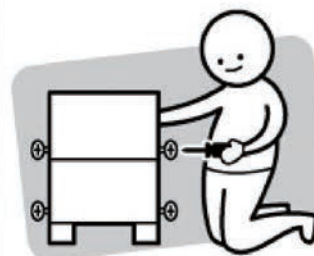
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

## Useful Information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.
- ! If you are having any difficulties assembling your product, missing any hardware or components please visit our website Help Centre for further assistance.

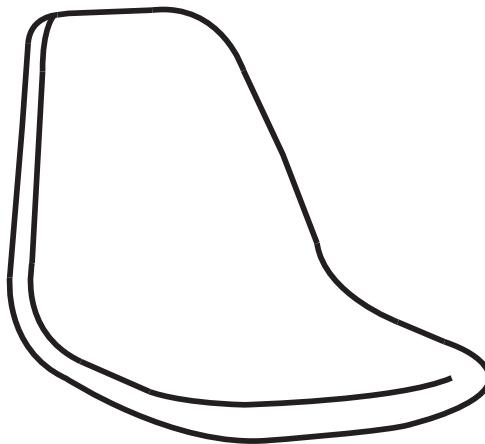

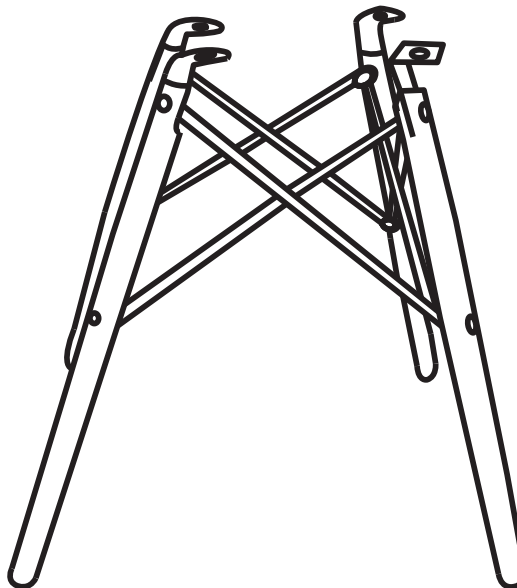

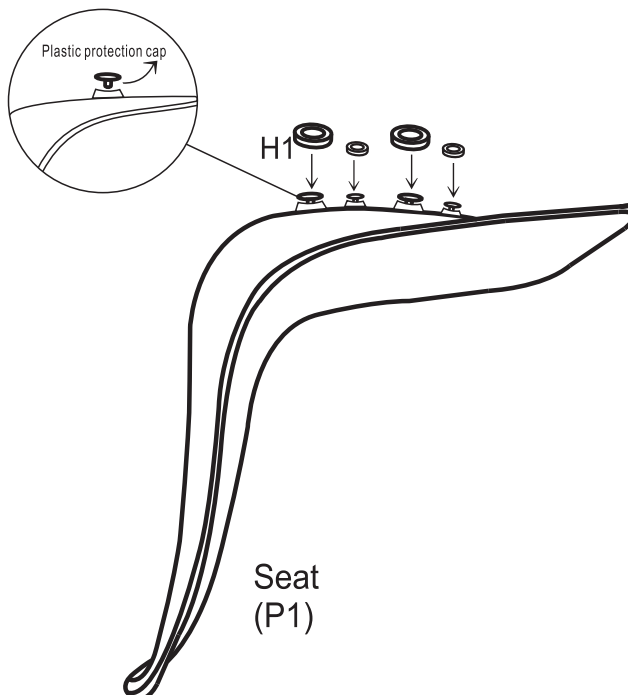

# Step 1

You will need:

| 4 x Plastic Washers (H1) |  |








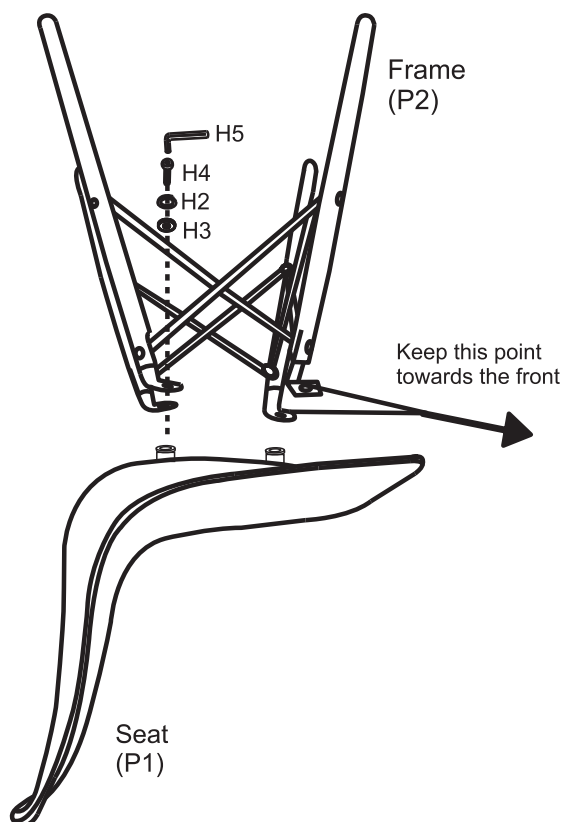
Place seat ( P1 ) on a soft covered surface.

Take out the 4 pcs plastic protection cap on the seat by hand before assembly.

Fix with 4 x Plastic Washes ( H1 ) on the seat .

# Step 2

| 1 x Frame (P2)          |  |
| 4 x Spring Washers (H2) |  |
| 4 x Washers (H3)        |  |
| 4 x Screws (H4)         |  |
| 1 x Allen Key (H5)      |  |



Position Frame ( P2 ) over the seat ( P1 ).

Align the holes on the Frame ( P2 ) to the Screw holes of the seat ( P1 ).

Fix Frame( P2 ) to the Seat ( P1 ) with 4 x Washers ( H3 ) and 4 x Spring Washers ( H2 ) and 4 x Screws ( H4 ).

Fully tighten the bolts using Allen Key ( H5 ).

Turn the chair over carefully.
