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Helpful bunk bed safety tips

Bunk beds should be checked periodically to ensure that the guardrail, ladder and other components are secure and in the correct position and all connectors are tight.

We recommend that children under the age of nine (9) do not use the upper bunk. Children should be discouraged from playing on the bunk bed.

No more than one occupant should use the upper bunk at any time (unless otherwise stated).

Bunk beds should be placed a minimum of 2 metres away from any ceiling fans to prevent any injury to the upper bunk occupant.

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
Assembly checklist



Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



before you begin assembly.



Identify and lay out all of the components Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful Information

! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.

!The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.

! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.

! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used as they may not fit through a door once assembled.

! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.

! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.








Please make sure you have all these parts before you start.





Attach the back guard rail (P5) and front guard rail (P6) to 3×2 mesh panels (P9) with 12×2 short bolts (H1) and 12×2 hex nuts (H4), tighten with allen keys (H5) as shown.




Attach the front side rail (P7) and back side rail (P8) to 3 \times mesh panels (P9) with 12 \times short bolts (H1) and 12 \times hex nuts (H4), tighten with allen keys (H5) as shown.

Step 3






Insert $4 \times \text{medium bolts}$ (H2) into the bottom holes of the headboard/footboard upper (P1 & P2) using the allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts and leave a gap of 5mm as shown.

Step 4






Insert 4 \times medium bolts (H2) into the bottom holes of the headboard/footboard lower (P3) using the allen key (H5). Do not fully tighten the bolts and leave a gap of 5mm as shown.



Step 5 You will need 4 x Medium Bolts (H2) M6x20 1 x Allen Key (H5) Two People P3 P7 P8 P8 P8




Attach the headboard and footboard upper (P1 & P2) to the front guardrail (P6) and back guardrail (P5) by slotting them on the lower bolts first, then insert 4 x medium bolts (H2) into the top holes and tighten with the allen key (H5).


Insert 3 x long bolts (H3) into the top holes of headboard (P1) and (P2) with the allen key (H5).



Step 7




First slot on the $4 \times mid$ posts (P4) onto the posts of the headboard/footboard lower panels (P3). Insert $8 \times medium$ bolts (H2) into the mid post and tighten 75% of the way with the allen key (H5). Then carefully lift and position the upper bed above the lower bed. Ensure that the two holes of the upper bed and lower bed are on the same side. Put the upper bed into position. Then insert $8 \times medium$ bolts (H2) into the mid posts and tighten with the allen key (H5) to lock the bunk






Step 9



IMPORTANT: Fully tighten all bolts on bed. Periodically check to ensure all bolts remain tight.



Note: In the future if you require two single beds, the bunk can be disassembled. Remember to remove the mid posts (P4) from the bottom bed and insert the spare leg plastic pads (H6) as shown.
