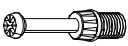



The head of the cam bolt goes into the open mouth of the cam nut. You then turn the cam nut so it tightens over the bolt.

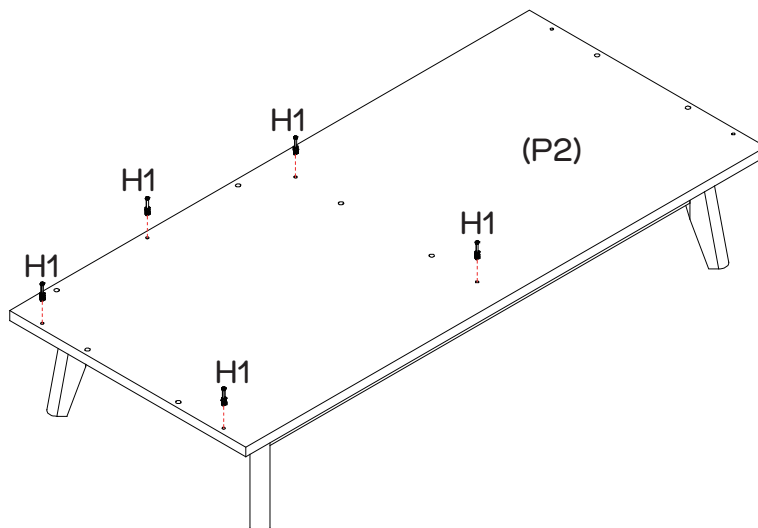

Rotate the cam nuts so the arrows point towards the incoming cam bolts
and turn clockwise to lock with a flat head screwdriver.


Attach 2 x separated slide tracks (H15-1) onto 2 x side panels (P3) with 6 x screws (H14), using a phillips head screwdriver as shown.
 Ensure the slide tracks (H15-1) are attached so the rubber stopper is positioned as shown.

Screw 1 x cam bolt (H1) into each side panel (P3), using a phillips head screwdriver as shown.

Insert 4 x dowels (H3) into 2 x side panels (P3) as shown.
 Use a mallet to gently tap the dowels into place if needed.




You will need	
	
2 x Slide Runners (H19-2)	6 x Screws 12mm (H18)
	
Phillips Head Screwdriver	


Please fasten the screws through these holes for this step.



Attach 1 x slide runner (H19-2) to each drawer side (P6, P7) with 3 x screws (H18), using a phillips head screwdriver as shown.





2 x Screws 28mm (H11)	1 x Handle (H4)
	
Phillips Head Screwdriver	




Attach 1 x handle (H4) onto drawer front (P5) with 2 x screws (H11), using a phillips head screwdriver as shown.


Step 17



Move inner ball bearing track to front of slide track (H19-1).







Gently insert drawer slide runner (H19-2) in between the ball bearing track.




Position drawer so that slide runners (H19-2) align with slide tracks (H19-1) as shown. Gently push drawer into the closed position.

You will need	
	
1 x Flat Washer (H9)	1 x Screw 25mm (H14)
	
1 x Wall Strap (H13)	Phillips Head Screwdriver

We strongly recommend that this product is permanently fixed to the wall or other suitable surface.




Fix 1 x wall strap (H13) to top panel (P1) with 1 x screw (H14) and 1 x flat washer (H9) as shown, using a phillips head screwdriver.



1 x Flat Washer (H9)	Phillips Head Screwdriver






Seek advice from a qualified trades person on how to attach this wall strap to your specific wall.
