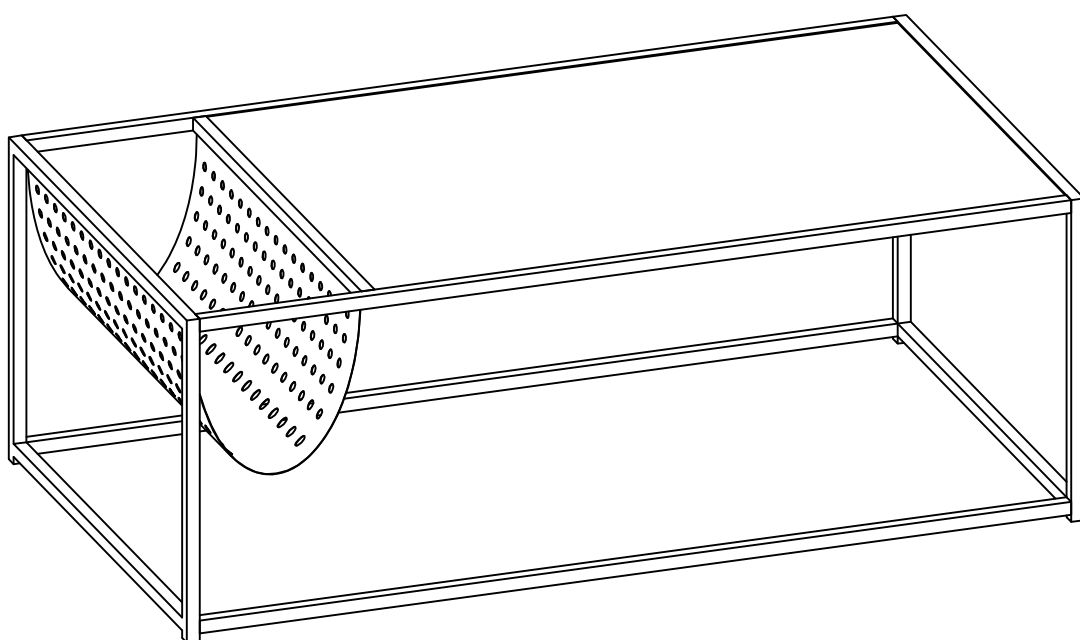

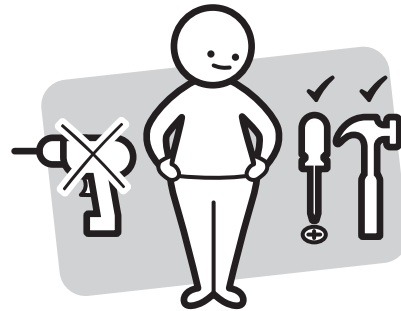

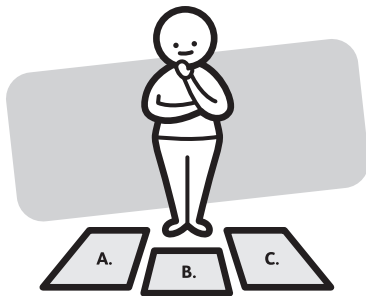
Assembly checklist



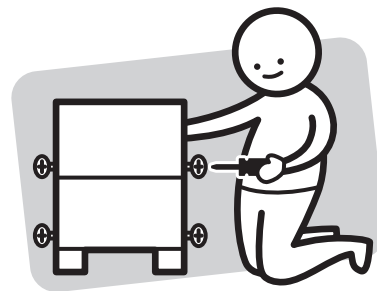
Read through the instructions carefully before you begin.



Make sure you have all the required tools. Never use power tools unless instructed.



Identify and lay out all of the components before you begin assembly.



Unless instructed, do not fully tighten screws until the item is fully assembled.

Useful information

- ! Never use power tools unless specifically instructed. They can damage your components or hardware if used incorrectly.
- ! The most common mistakes made during assembly are using the wrong hardware or getting components back to front.
- ! Always use a soft surface (such as carpet or cardboard) when assembling your product to avoid scratching or damaging the surface of the product.
- ! Bulky items such as wardrobes and bunk beds should be assembled in the room they will be used in as they may not fit through a door once assembled.
- ! Never use any glue until you are certain that the parts belong together.
- ! Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. Check the product care label or website for product care instructions.

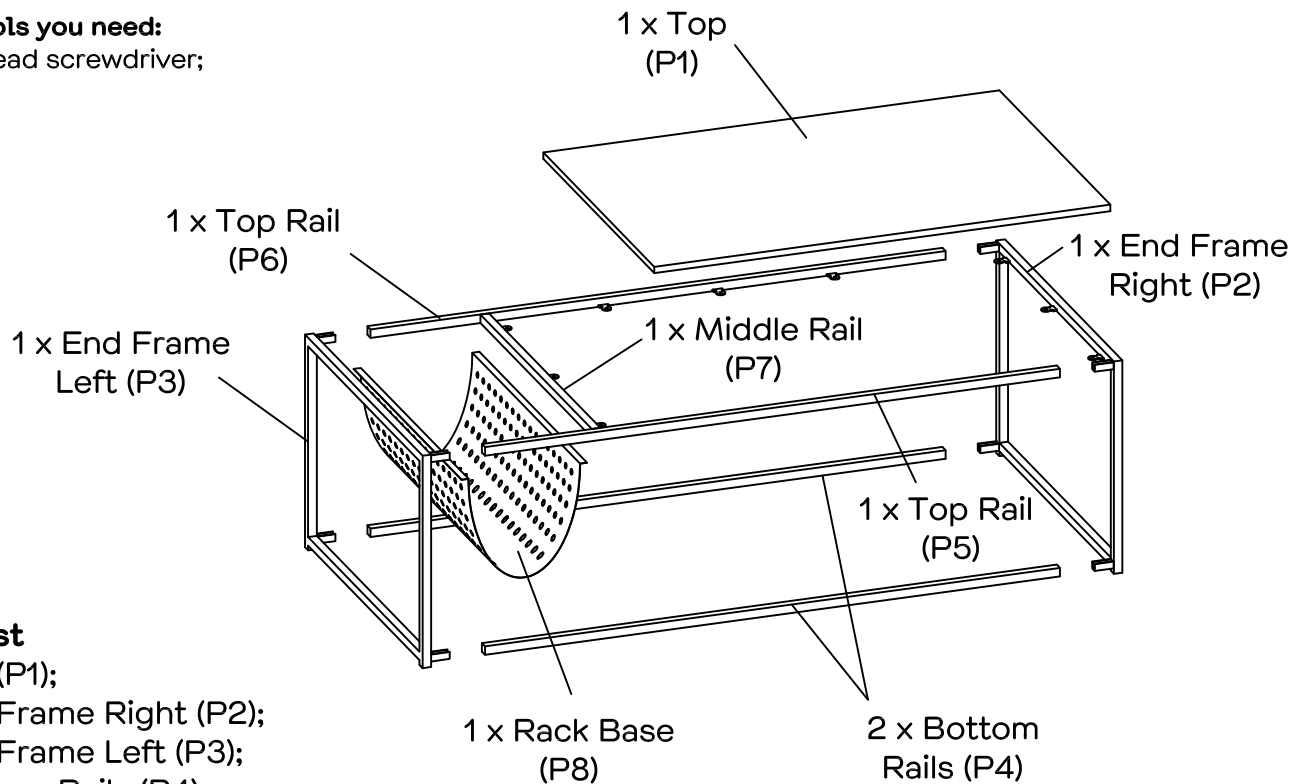

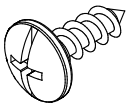

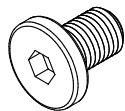

1 x Rack Base (P8);

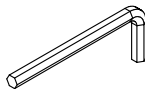

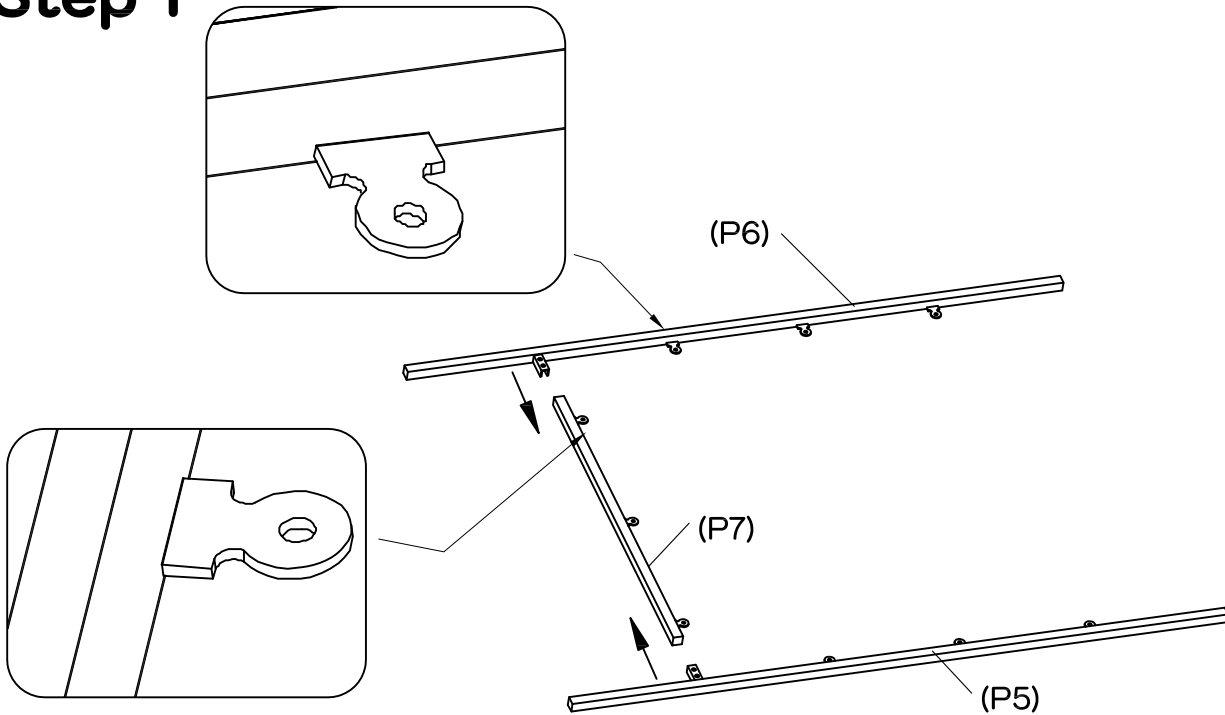

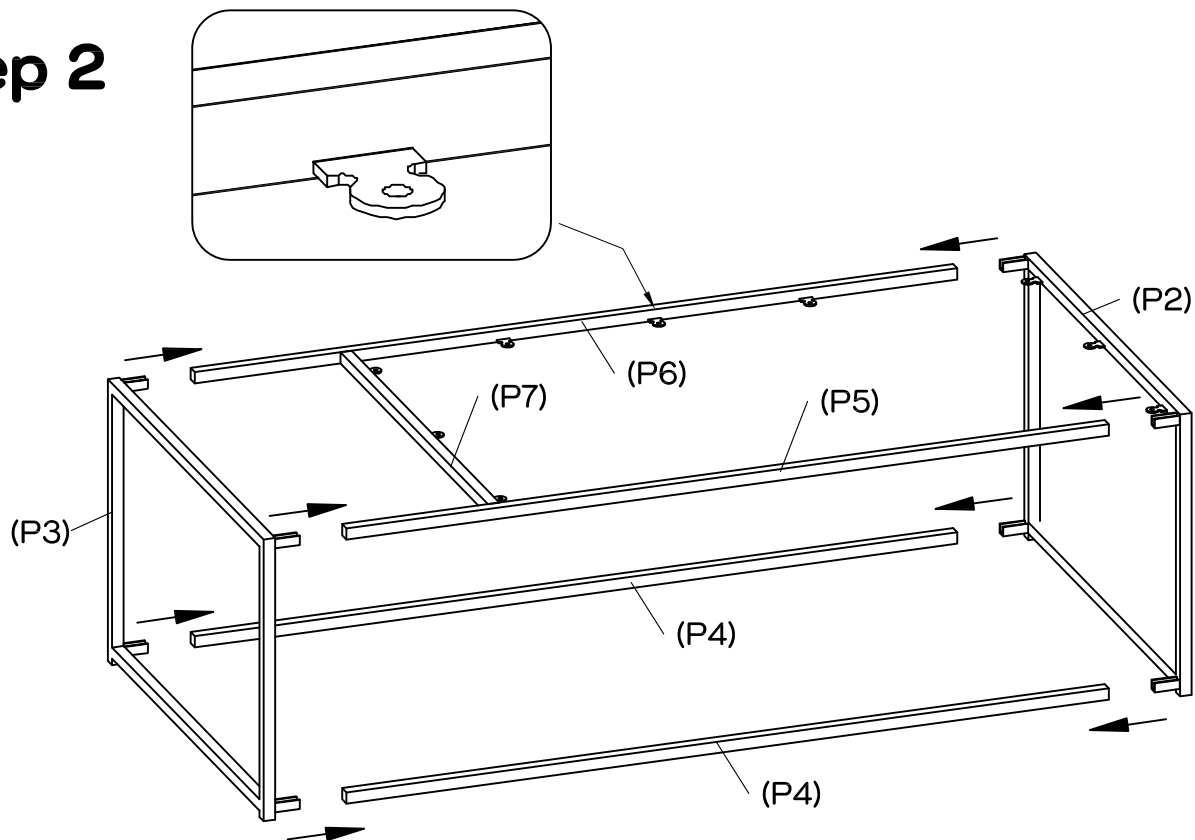

Step 1





Attach the Top Rails (P5&P6) to the Middle Rail (P7) as shown. Ensure the metal tabs on the Top Rails (P5&P6) and Middle Rail (P7) are rotated into shown position.

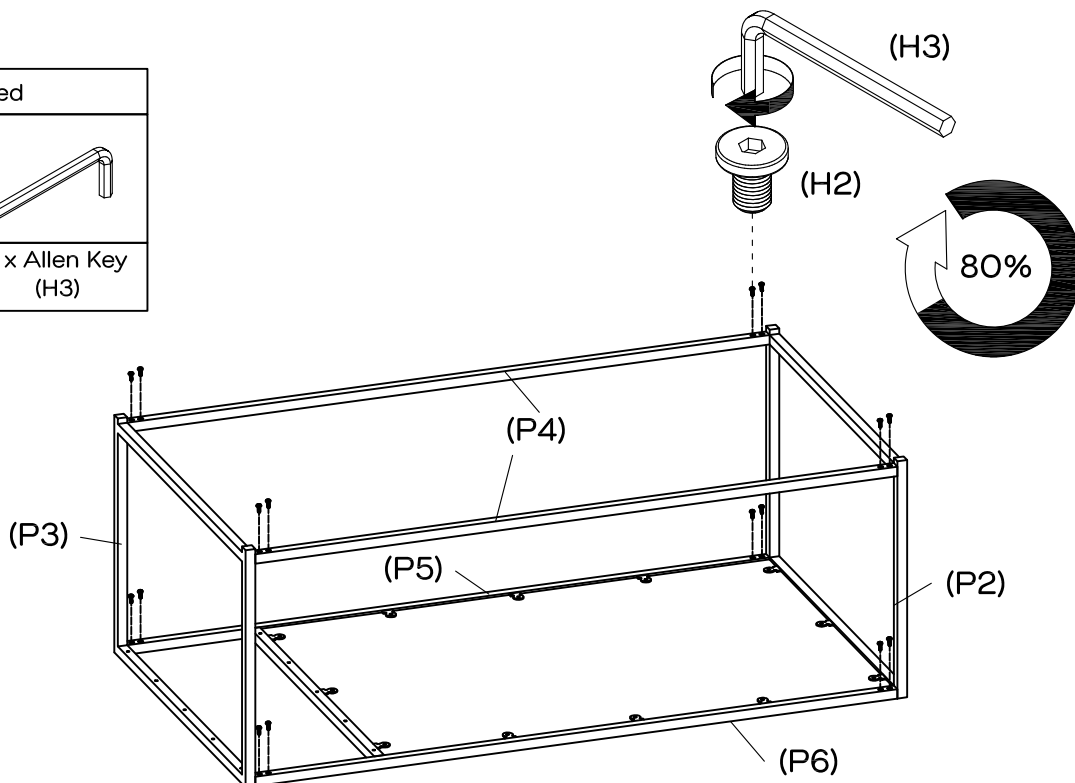
Step 2



Attach the assembled Top and Middle Rails (P5,P6&P7) and the Bottom Rails (P4x2) to the End Frame Left & Right (P2&P3) as shown. Ensure the metal tabs on the Top Rails and Middle Rail (P5,P6&P7) and the End Frame Right (P2) are rotated into shown position.



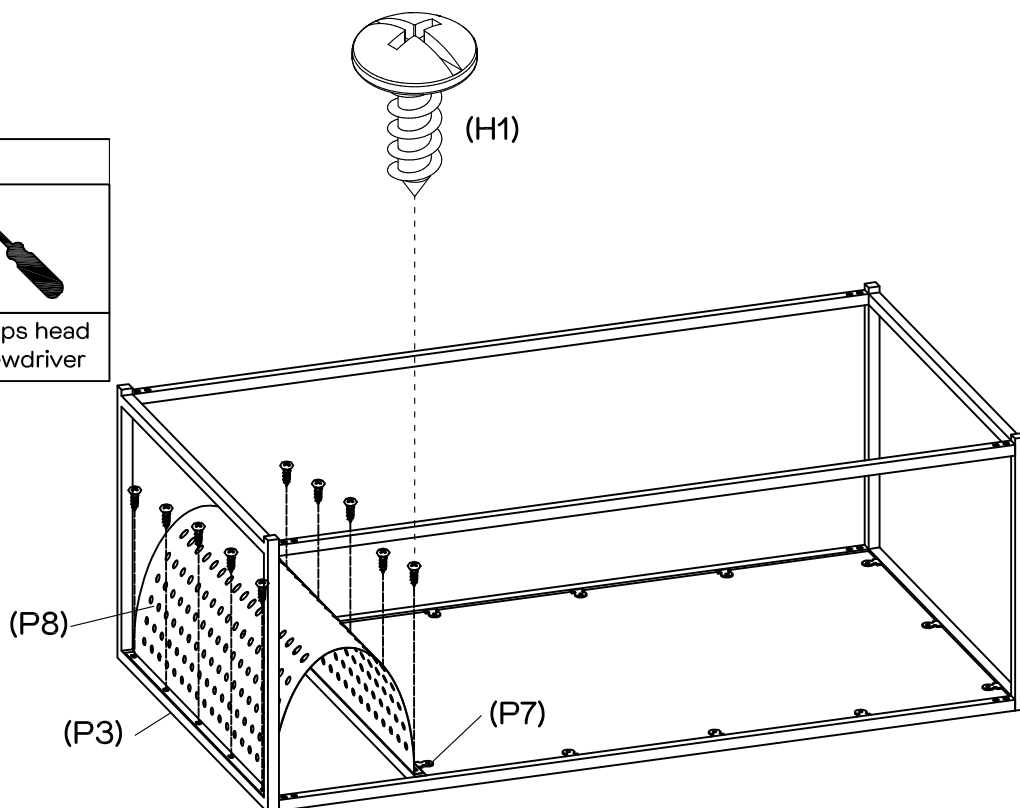
You will need	
	
16 x Bolts (H2)	1 x Allen Key (H3)



Secure the Top Rails and Middle Rail (P5,P6&P7) and the Bottom Rails (P4x2) to the End Frame Left & Right (P2&P3) with 16 x Bolts (H2) by tightening with the Allen Key (H3). Do not fully tighten Bolts, tighten only to 80 %




Attach the Rack Base (P8) to the End Frame Left (P3) and Middle Rail (P7) using Screws (H1) and Phillips Head Screwdriver

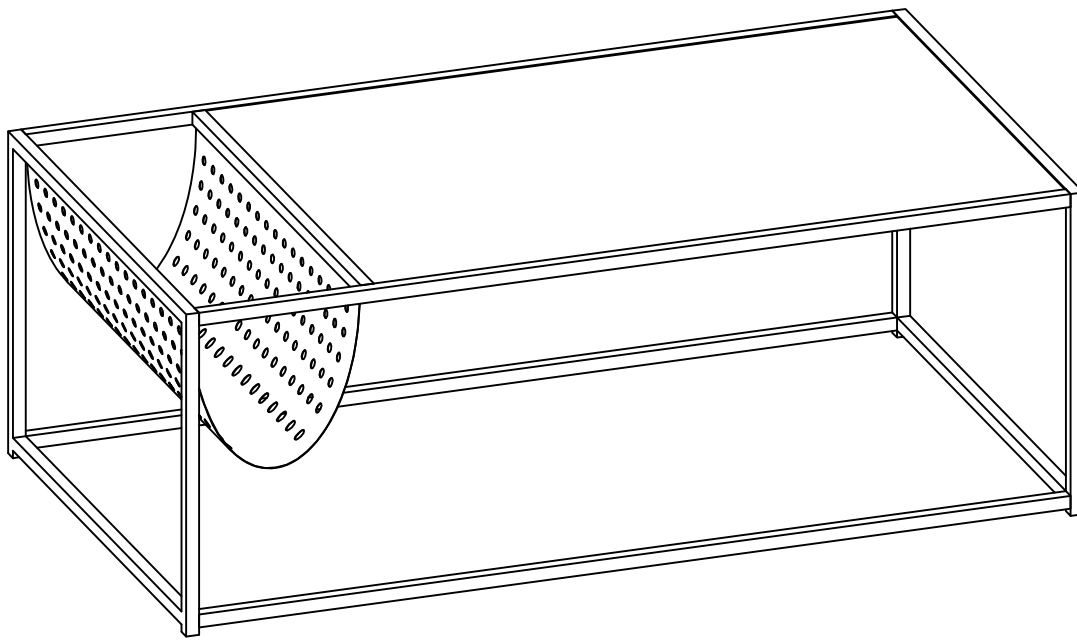
Step 5

12 x Screws (H1)	1 x Allen Key (H3)
	
Phillips head screwdriver	



Place the Top (P1) into the assembled frame as shown.
Secure the Top (P1) to the Top Rails and Middle Rails (P5,P6&P7) and the End Frame Right (P2) using Screws (H1) and Phillips Head Screwdriver
Tighten all Bolts (H2) to 100 % using the Allen Key (H3)
