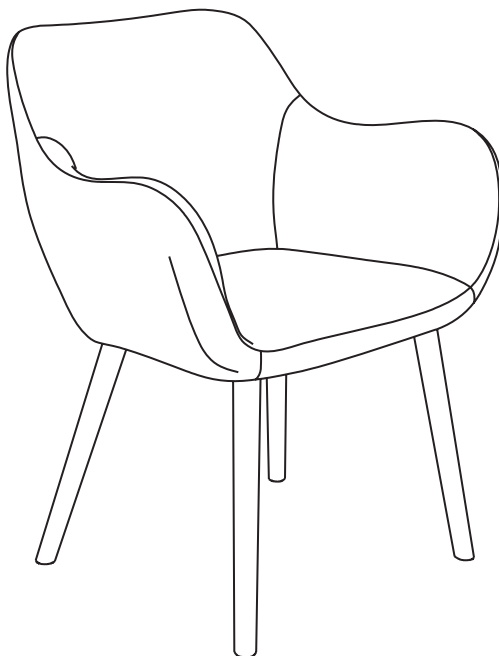
# Step 1

Mount 2 x front leg (P1) and 2 x back leg (P2) to seat (P3) using washers (H2), bolts (H1) and allen key (H4).  
Attach felt pads (H3) to legs.

Insert each Wood Dowel (H5) into leg (P2).  
Attach each Felt Feet (H6) onto Leg (P2).

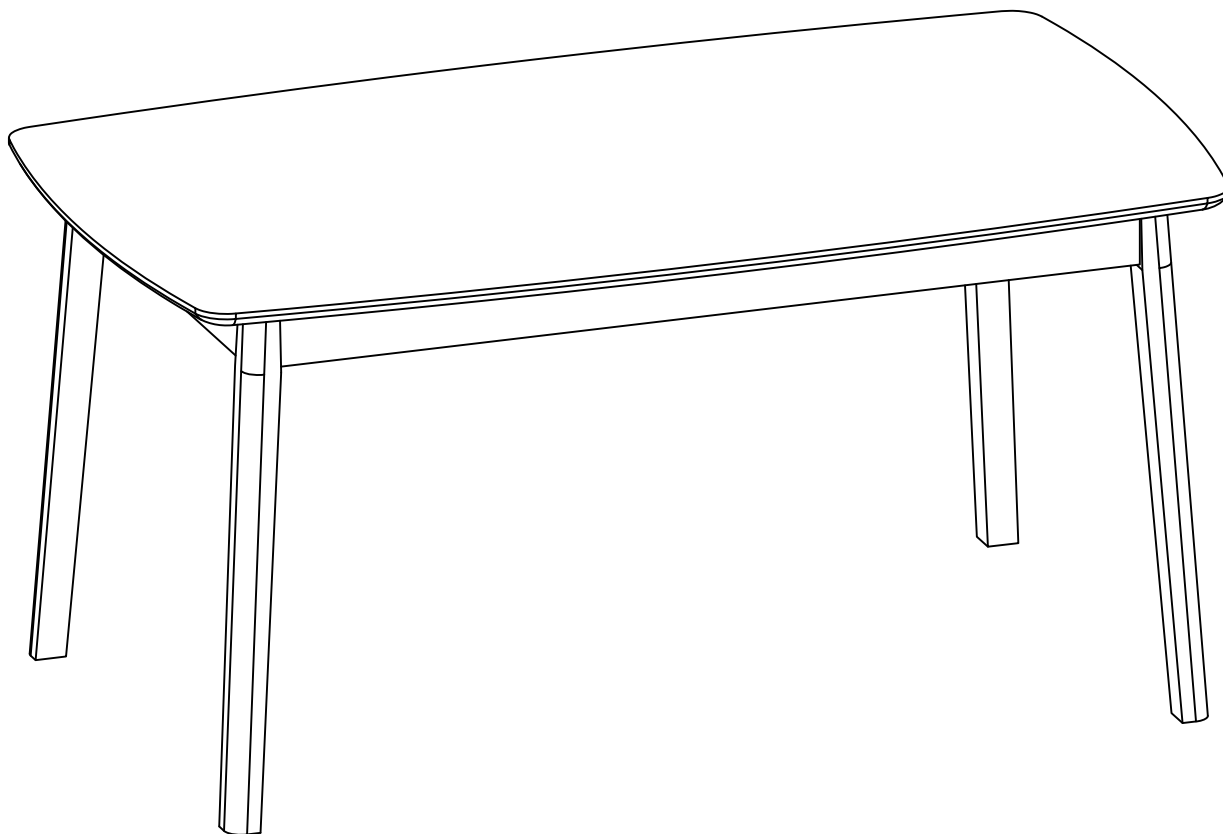
## Step 2

You will need	
	
8 x Bolts (H1)	8 x Spring Washers (H2)
	
8 x Flat Washers (H3)	Allen Key (H4)



Attach Leg (P2) onto Top (P1) using 2 x Bolts (H1), 2 x Flat Washers (H3) and 2 x Spring Washers (H2).  
Tighten the bolt with Allen Key (H4).  
Repeat three times for all Legs (P2).
